Cornish Library & Community Center Updates

Building Committee Update

Working collaboratively with Banwell Architects and four subcommittees, the Building Committee has completed the design work for the library. We are now starting the three-month construction documentation phase. The construction firm, Trumbull-Nelson, has estimated the renovation costs to be approximately \$2.6 million. After adding architecture service, construction management and furniture costs, the total cost for the new library will be approximately \$3 million. The bidding and construction phases will take 12 - 15 months combined, but our start date will depend on the timing of the fundraising activities.

Fundraising Committee Update

Our \$3M Capital Campaign has been established. We are in the quiet phase, reaching out to leadership donors. To date, \$800K has been received in donations and pledges. A Northern Borders Regional Commission Grant pre-application has been submitted. We will know in April if we are eligible to submit a formal application.
