Cornish Library & Community Center Updates

The Fundraising Committee has reached the first Million Dollar Milestone in our \$3 Million UNITE, BUILD, GROW Capital Campaign!!! There will be a Milestone Celebration on Sat, May 4, from 10-noon. Watch for details on ConnectCornish.

Our pre-application to the Northern Borders Regional Commission was accepted. The next application deadline is early May. We have connected with the Upper Valley advisor at the NH Charitable Foundation. Our Case Statement brochure will be ready soon. We have been reaching out to leadership donors and are applying for grant funds. If you know of any foundations or grant opportunities, please reach out to any CCI Board member.

The Building Committee continues to meet with Banwell Architects, our team of engineers and our construction manager Trumbull-Nelson on a bi-weekly basis to decide on the additional details needed to finalize the construction documents. Caroline Storrs will lead the Furniture Subcommittee who will initiate the process of selecting a furniture vendor. The specifications for all equipment to be used in the new library are currently being gathered. The land survey has been completed and it is expected that our civil engineer will submit the driveway application with the NH Department of Transportation in the coming weeks.
